

Cybersecurity Threats and Scam Alerts

A growing number of investors have become targets of highly sophisticated online scams. In particular, impersonation scams have recently been on the rise in Hong Kong and globally. Suspicious website operators often use names similar to legitimate companies to confuse investors. We wish to urge investors to utilise alerts posted on the website of Hong Kong Securities and Futures Commission (SFC), and the International Securities and Commodities Alerts Network (I-SCAN) of International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO).

Investors may also utilize tools from trustworthy resources to obtain information about cybersecurity threats and scams, such as the website of Scameter, CyberDefender, the Anti-Deception Coordination Centre, and the Investor and Financial Education Council.

Protecting Your Interests

For purpose of client assets protection, we wish to urge investors to take appropriate measures to protect your interests. We set out below some examples for your reference:

- Please properly safeguard your key personal information, such as specimen signatures, account login names and passwords, information about your investment and bank accounts, etc.;
- Please stay vigilant and avoid clicking on embedded hyperlinks in short message service (SMS) messages and entering confidential personal information, user credentials and OTPs into websites or mobile applications that you are re-directed to;
- Please inform us of any changes in your personal particulars in a timely manner;
- Please promptly check your trading documents including statements of account, and contact our Operation Team¹ in case of any discrepancies in your accounts; and
- Please report promptly to the Hong Kong Police Force (HKPF) any unauthorised trading incidents or scams.

The above examples are not meant to be exhaustive. You are advised to stay vigilant.
